



# 53<sup>RD</sup> Annual WinnebagoLand Art Fair

Sunday, June 13, 2010 10AM - 4PM Rain or Shine

South Park, Oshkosh Corner of Georgia & South Park Avenue

\$2,500 in Awards

**Eligibility:** Participation is open to artists who exhibit works of **original concept and execution**. The artist certifies that all work is in strict conformity with these rules, agrees that the Art Fair Committee is the sole arbiter of any dispute, and that the decision of the Art Fair Committee is final and binding on all persons. The Art Fair Committee reserves the right to reject any entry or exhibit that does not comply with these rules and the exhibitor will be asked to leave the show. No refund will be given.

**\$2,500 in Awards: \$500 Best of Show, plus 10 awards of \$200 each.**

**Acceptable Work:**

- Original painting
- Wood or stone carvings
- Pottery (no commercial molds)
- Metal sculpture
- Jewelry (handcrafted, originally designed)
- Glass
- Batik, other handcrafted fabric arts
- Drawing, Pen/Ink, Engraving, Etching, Prints, etc.
- Photographs
- Wall hangings
- Basketry, Fiber Arts (handcrafted, original design)

**The Type of Medium** in the photos an artist submits for the jury must be representative of the work to be sold. Art Fair Committee reserves the right to refuse work at the Fair that is not consistent with submitted photos. One artist per booth.

**All Work Must be Original:** No more than 25% of any artist's display may consist of commercial reproductions. Reproductions must be signed and numbered as to size of edition.

**Non-Acceptable Work:** No copied work (including work copied from published photos); no commercial items; no kits; no stuffed toys or pillows; no bazaar or craft items, etc. Acceptable art will be determined by the jury.

**Selection of Exhibitors:** All applicants will be juried. Submit 3 clear, sharp 4" x 6" photos representing the scope of your **most current** work, plus a photo of your booth set-up.

**Photo Note:** Make sure you have good photos, as they will determine the jury results. Acceptance by the jury is NOT based on past award winners, past exhibitors, or number of years you may have exhibited.

**Notification Process:** Enclose a SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE (SASE) 9-1/2" x 4" with your entry form for the return of your photos and notification as to your participation. Exhibitors will be screened during the fair to ensure that work shown reflects work represented in the photos submitted to the jury.

**Entry Fee:** \$90 per space, refundable if applicant is not juried into the show. Fee is NON-REFUNDABLE once applicant has been juried into art fair. Spaces are assigned as entries are received and are non-transferable. Please indicate on the entry form if you require special accommodation due to a disability.

**Jury Fee:** \$10 per entry. Non-refundable.

**Deadline:** Returning Artist application deadline is March 15, 2010. Notification & acceptance will be sent out by April 15. First come, first juried. New Artist (new to our event) application deadline is March 31, 2010.

**Late Applications:** Late Entry fee until April 10 is \$20 plus the \$90 space fee and the \$10 jury fee. Entry is limited to the first 160 applicants only. **Walk-in entries will not be accepted.**

**Set-up & Exhibition:** Space provided is approximately 20 feet x 20 feet. Entrants provide all display equipment. Props, display material and artwork must be in place by 10:00am at which time judging begins. Artists wishing to demonstrate are encouraged to do so. This is an outdoor fair and each artist is responsible for protection of their work from the elements.  
**No refunds due to weather.**

**Parking, maps, hotel info, and details** will be sent with acceptance notification letter. All sale proceeds go to the artist. Exhibitors are responsible for reporting their own Sales Tax.

**Food:** Coffee and donuts will be served to artists and booth assistant, compliments of OFAA. Food will be available for purchase to artists and the public throughout the day on the grounds.
