OFAA Meeting Minutes from Oct. 2010

Treasurer's report

- \$10,700.57 total
- \$4735.28 is scholarship
- \$5439.34 available to us

Membership fees are now due

- We want to make this an inclusive group - not exclusive - try to add new members
- Dues of \$20 individual/\$30 couple covers from now through next August
- Renewals not paid by Dec. will be dropped from the member list

Committee Reports

- Workshops - many ideas, a work in process
- Programs - The workshop committee will absorb these duties (Joye, Shirley & Caroline)
- Art Fair - The board met this summer and made some changes to the art fair:(1) the booth fee was \$90 with \$10 jury fee and we have opted to eliminate the jury fee, (2) the fee for a member to have their own booth has been raised from \$30 to \$45 if membership eligibility is met (3) the Members' Booth has become too expensive so we are encouraging members to have their own booth or to share a booth (4) the Members' Booth fee has been raised from \$10 to \$20
- SOFA Show- call Michalene, 235-7447 this was listed as a free trip but questions were raised about it not being free in the past and this will be addressed
- Oshkosh Mural - Kathy Murphy reported the silent auction was a success with about 20 people donating art pieces. The first month saw approx. 200 visitors

The framed/larger pieces are still up for auction through Dec. \$275 was raised from the first round and you can still donate artwork for the auction by contacting Kathy

New Business

- Kathy Murphy motioned to donate \$500 to the Mural Fund from the OFAA - motion passed
- Joyce Tornow will take on the "Artist of the Month" and will randomly choose a member for a monthly interview and write-up in the newsletter
- A question was raised as to whether or not we had given an award to RAP (Wisconsin Regional Artist Assoc.) We did not, as it was not brought up for discussion in the past year.
- Heidi Burnett suggested that with downtown soon to re-open, we might consider if a 'plien air' event could be established in cooperation with the downtown BID Board to act as a public relations and a fund raising option for our general fund. Heidi, Susan and Jenna will look into this further.
- Cheryl McCarthy reminded all about the Harvest Noon Madness Art Show at the convention center Nov. 5 & 6
- Elaine Fisher, who was a long time member, passed away last Wed. It is suggested that we establish an art fair memorial award in her name
- Holiday party info was shared and will be in the newsletter
